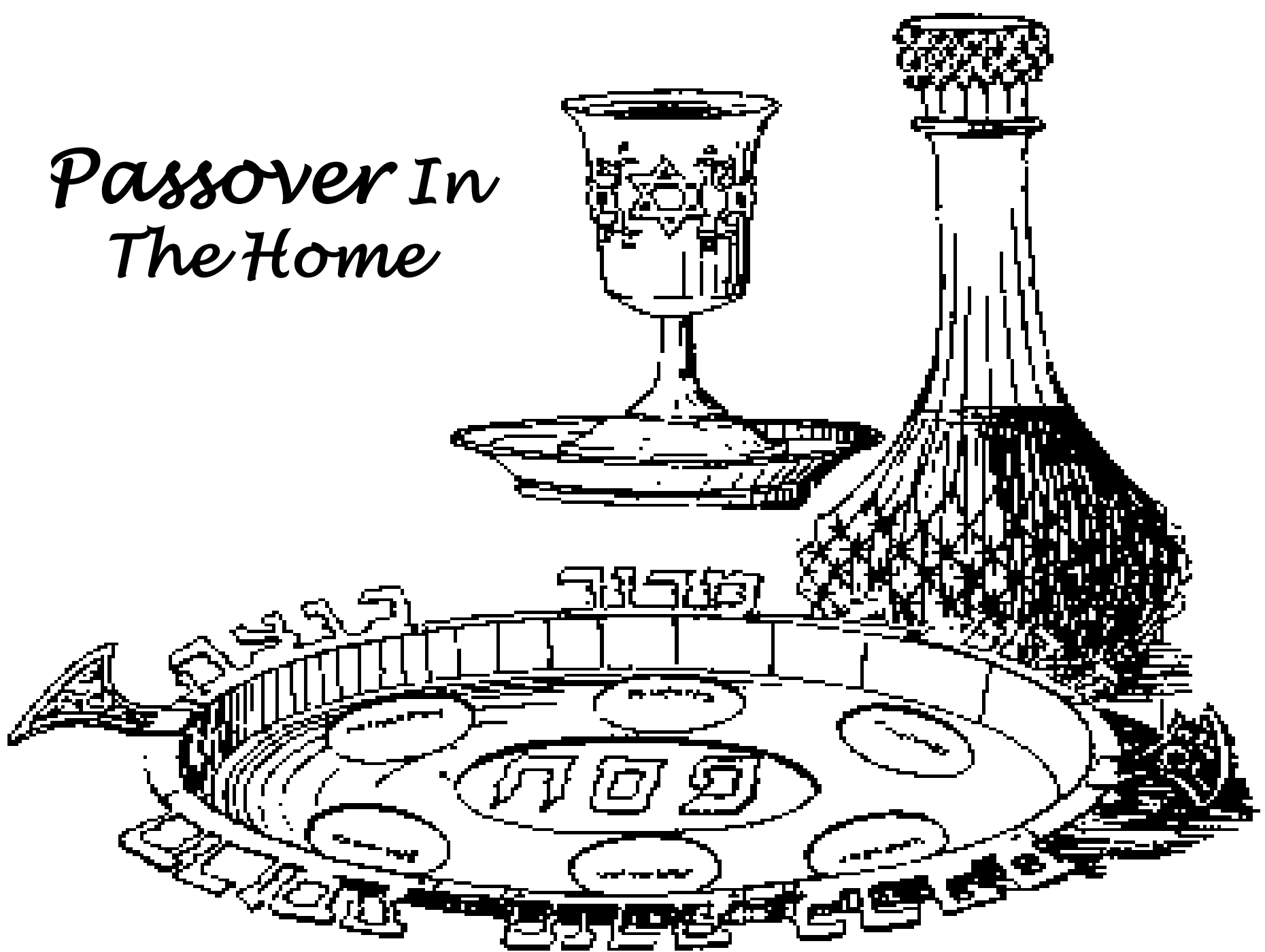

THE FEAST OF PASSOVER

- **Lev 23:2** *Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, Concerning the feasts of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim to be holy convocations, even these are my feasts. (KJV)*
- **Ex 12:24-25** *And you shall observe this thing as an ordinance for you and your sons forever. 25 It will come to pass when you come to the land which the LORD will give you, just as He promised, that you shall keep this service. NKJV*
- **Luke 22:15-16** *Then He said to them, "With fervent desire I have desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer; 16 for I say to you, I will no longer eat of it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God."*
- **Acts 12:4** *And when he had apprehended him, he put him in prison, and delivered him to four quaternions of soldiers to keep him; intending after Easter to bring him forth to the people. (KJV)*

"Easter"

- **Note here that "Easter"**, should be translated by its Aramaic word as "PASSOVER"-----NOT EASTER!
 - **pascha (pas'-khah)**;
of Aramaic origin [compare 6453]; the Passover (the meal, the day, the festival or the special sacrifices connected with it):
 - KJV-- Easter, Passover is the only bible translating it as easter.
- **The Feast of Passover**, is the first month of the sacred year to the calendar of God.
 - God's spiritual calendar is the 1st. month starting in April
 - On the Jewish national calendar it is the 7th. Month.

So Here Is How The Biblical Calendar Works

March/April Spring

- **On the 10th. day of Nissan 1st. month (Tues.) the Lamb is set aside for sacrifice.**
- **On the 14th. day of Nissan 1st. month (Sat.) the Lamb is slain, The Feast of Passover.**
- **On the 15th.-21st. day Nissan of the 1st. month is, Unleavened Bread.**

June Summer

- **On the 1st. Sunday after Passover is, The Feast of First Fruits.**
- **50 days after First Fruits is, The Feast of Pentecost Sivan 6-7.**

September/October Fall

- **On 1st. & 2nd. Day of Tishrei is Feast of Trumpets (Israel's New Year).**
- **On the 10th. day of the 7th. month is, The Day of Atonement (Yom Kippur).**
- **On the 15th.-21st. day of the 7th. month is, The Feast of Tabernacles.**

THE FOUR DAYS OF THE HIDDEN LAMB

- *Exod 12:3-6* Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, **In the tenth day** of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb, according to the house of their fathers, a lamb for an house. 4 And if the household be too little for the lamb, let him and his neighbor next unto his house take it according to the number of the souls; every man according to his eating shall make your count for the lamb. 5 **Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year:** ye shall take it out from the sheep, or from the goats: And ye shall **keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month:** and the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it in the evening. (KJV)

Dispensationally

- The scripture tells us that "a day unto the Lord is as a thousand years and thousand years as a day".
 - **Ps 90:4** *For a thousand years in thy sight are but as yesterday when it is past, and as a watch in the night.*
 - **2 Pet 3:8** *But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. (KJV)*
- When Adam sinned God set aside His lamb, Jesus Christ was for ordained to die. From Adam to Jesus we have 4000 yrs. Or 4 days.
 - WEEKLY TIME 10th. – 14th. day 4 days or 4 thousand years.
 - In the event of Jesus He entered on the 10th. day and was slain on the 14th day four days later.

A Lamb Of The First Year

***Exod 12:5** Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year: ye shall take it out from the sheep, or from the goats:*

- **The first born lamb** was to be set apart. This first born lamb was to be given to the Lord with specific instructions.

***Exod 4:22-23** And thou shalt say unto Pharaoh, **Thus saith the LORD, Israel is my son, even my firstborn**: 23 And I say unto thee, **Let my son go, that he may serve me**: and if thou refuse to let him go, behold, I will slay thy son, even thy firstborn.(KJV)*

The Theme Of The First Born

1. Cain is set aside for Abel.
2. Ishamael is set aside for Isaac.
3. Esau is set aside for Jacob.
4. Egypt is set aside for Israel.

What Is Pesach?

- **Pesach** is a major Jewish spring festival, commemorating the Exodus from Egypt over 3000 years ago.
- This observance centers around a special home service (the *seder*), the prohibition of leaven (*chametz*), and the eating of *matzah*.
- The central meaning of Passover (Pesach) is liberation, and hence it is also called *zeman cherutenu*--the season of our liberation.

Haggadah

- Another name for Passover is Haggadah: the holiday of spring.
- ***Haggadah*** comes from the root meaning "***to tell***" and reflects the purpose of the evening--the retelling of the story of the Exodus, especially to the next generation.

We Are Commanded To Observe Three Items

1. **To tell the story** of the Exodus. As the Torah states: *"Remember this day, on which you went free from Egypt, the house of bondage, how Adonai freed you from it with a mighty hand...."*(Exodus 13:3).
2. **No eating or owning** chametz--unleavened bread. As the Torah states: *"On the very first day, you shall remove leaven from your houses, for whoever eats leavened bread from the first day to the seventh day, that person shall be cut off from Israel"* (Exodus 12:15).
 - Bitter Herbs
3. **The Shank Bone Of The Lamb**
Exod 12:21 Then Moses called for all the elders of Israel and said to them, "Pick out and take lambs for yourselves according to your families, and kill the Passover lamb. (NKJ)
