“When he had spit on the [blind] mans eyes and put his hands on him, Jesus asked, do you see anything? He looked up and said I see people; they look like trees walking around. Once more Jesus put his hands on the man’s eyes. Then his eyes were opened, his sight was restored, and he saw everything clearly.” Mark 8:23-25
