



Kairos Timing

Prior to celebrating Passover each year the Holy Spirit has given our fellowship a prophetic theme. This theme has become the prophetic exhortation for our New Year (i.e. Rosh Hashanah 2012).

⌘ **For 2012 it is: Jer 29:11-14 CJB. I Will Reverse Your Exile. All Areas Of Captivity Will Be Restored To Wholeheartedness.**

"For I know what plans I have in mind for you," says Adonai, 'plans for well-being, not for bad things; so that you can have hope and a future. When you call to me and pray to me, I will listen to you. When you seek me, you will find me, provided you seek for me wholeheartedly; and I will let you find me,' says Adonai. 'Then I will reverse your exile. I will gather you from all the nations and places where I have driven you,' says Adonai, 'and bring you back to the place from which I exiled you.'" Jer 29:11-14 CJB

⌘ For 2011 it was: Don't Lower Your Gaze. Do Not Focus On The Boisterous Conditions Surrounding You! Matt 14:22-31 CJB

⌘ For 2010 it was: The Removal Of Toxic Emotions. Do Not Let The Voices Of Your Past Define Your Future! Isa 43:18-19 TEV

I believe that the Body of Christ is on the verge of some incredible Kairos moments in 2012. This is not to say that during this year the Body of Christ will not experience colossal challenges, but found within those challenges will be a hope and future that repeals any exiled areas of sin or lost opportunities.

There are two Greek words used for time: Chronos and Kairos.

⌘ **Chronos time:** is ordinary time as we know it today. We could use the term "tick-tock" time to describe Chronos time.

⌘ **Kairos time:** could be described as a God-given moment of destiny; the floodtide of opportunity in which the unseen mysteries of heaven surge downward into our present situations. A time when heaven touches us in such a way our lives are changed forever.

Is it possible to miss a Kairos moment? Absolutely! I'm sure there are many Christians who have missed a Kairos moment with God and are now wandering around in the desert paying a great price for their missed opportunity. The Apostle Paul exhorts us to not miss Kairos timing; *"And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now our salvation is nearer than when we first believed."* Romans 13:11

If the Body of Christ does not wake up and perceive the time, she will miss her Kairos moment/season with God. In Chronos time (tick-tock), there is time to make decisions and God will usually wait for us to be obedient, but a Kairos moment says, "Now is the time!" If the moment is missed, there is no getting it back. Don't slumber this year away in toxic emotions or terrified by the boisterous conditions of your challenges! Ask the Holy Spirit give you discernment and wisdom to recognize this Kairos season.

Dearest friends, do you know what time it is in your life? Are you discerning the times? Is the Lord trying to break in and wake you up? If He is, then you are about to experience something new? I pray that you will have ears to hear, eyes to see and a heart to receive this Kairos word; *"I Will Reverse Your Exile, All Areas Of Captivity Will Be Restored To Wholeheartedness."* Return-Return-Return, don't allow the enemy to distract or deceive you from what God has for you! What do you need reversed in 2012?

I have listed four attitudes that will help us embrace.... *a God-given moment of destiny; the floodtide of opportunity in which the unseen mysteries of heaven surge downward into your present situations. A "KAIROS" time when heaven touches you in such a way your life changes forever!*

APPLICATION:

1. We will not open the 2012 gates to the dolorous (sad or painful) notes of sackcloth, but to the sweet strains of the harp of joy, and the high sounding cymbals of gladness.
2. Let others lament over their troubles, we have the sweetening tree to cast into Mariah's bitter pool; with joy will we magnify the Lord and see our waters sweet.
3. Jesus must have the crown of our heart's delight; we will not dishonor our Bridegroom by mourning over sin or lost opportunities of our past.
4. We are ordained to be the minstrels of the heavens, let us rehearse our everlasting anthem on the earth before we sing it in the halls of the New Jerusalem.

"Therefore I will play music before the Lord. And I will be even more undignified than this, and will be humble in my own sight." King David full of gladness and joy in the Kairos return of the Arc. 2 Sam 6:21-22 NKJV

Need there be any limit to our rejoicing in the Lord in 2012? What mysteries are waiting for us to discover in Jesus during 2012? Lord, favor us this year with such a sense of your preciousness, that from its first to its last day we may be glad and rejoice in Thee. Let January open with joy in the Lord, and December close with gladness in Jesus.
